



Argon 1.1 Release Notes

System updates available for use on Thursday, April 27, 2017.

This first system update after the statewide launch of the TB model on March 6th includes a few system enhancements, as well as changes to data and security. Not all changes will be detectable by users but were made to protect security, improve system functionality, or allow users access to data. All changes apply to the TB model and some impact the system as a whole.

Changes are described briefly below, and a more detailed change list is attached.
