



HOW TO DOWNLOAD YOUR OPERATING PERMIT

Step 1—Go to the Sentry Internet Home page.

- Option 1: Click this link to go directly to the <u>Sentry Internet</u> <u>Home Page</u>.
- Option 2: Type in the address or click on the link below. <u>https://fortress.wa.gov/doh/eh/po</u> <u>rtal/odw/si/Intro.aspx</u>



Step 2—Click Start.

 From the Sentry Internet Home page, click on "Start."



Step 3—Find your Water System.

- Enter your Water System ID.
- Click Submit.

Pro Tip: For best results, **only enter your Water System ID**. Entering additional information, like the Water System Name, will limit the search results and your water system might not pull up.

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Step 4—Click on the "Operating Permits" tab.



Step 5—Click on the blue link, "Current Operating Permit Report."



Step 6—View your Operating Permit.

Scroll down to page 3 to see the operating permit.

Pro Tip: To save a copy of your permit, right-click on it, then left-click save.
